



The Aims of this Training

- Train facilitators for Group Facilitation.
- Provide first level skills and lay the foundations for higher levels of training.
- Provide a training rooted in Heart Spirituality, discernment, accompaniment, and self-discovery (Formation of the Heart).
- Provide a process-oriented approach to facilitation.
- Enable facilitation practice with groups in the Chevalier family.
- Gain confidence in facilitation.
- Provide accreditation and recognition that is endorsed by the MSC General Conference.
- Provide a register of competent and trained facilitators.
- Grow communities of Facilitators across the Chevalier Family and beyond.

The Training

This is a 14-week Training. There are 8 online Modules and a 2-week Residential Intensive.

Online Modules

Each online Module, (apart from the Orientation and Concluding Modules), has 5 Units which you complete at your own pace and according to your own schedule. You will complete an average of 4 Units each week, a commitment of 4-5 hours online weekly.

Online Communities &

Accompaniment

Each week participants are also expected to join a weekly Online Learning Community of 70 minutes, and will also have one hour of online accompaniment with their designated Trainer.

Face to Face Practicum

The two-week residential intensive will involve experiential learning, in which trainees will facilitate one another, accompanied by their Trainers. They will engage in real-time facilitation reflecting on their practice, skills, attentiveness, listening, and noticing what in themselves hinders and allows authentic discernment and facilitation.

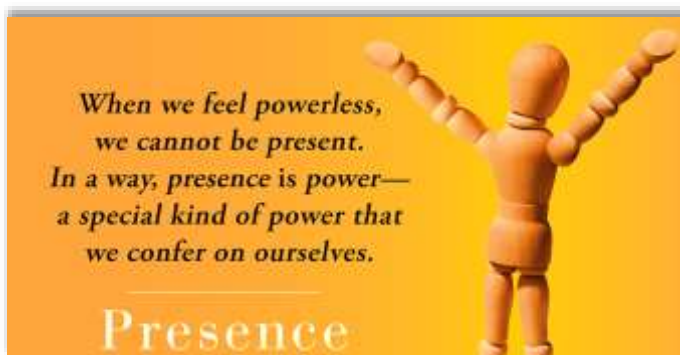
